

Biography

Born Alexander O Uwaifo, Andre Vibez was raised in the historic city of Benin, in Nigerias south south region, and began his musical career in his early teens as a keyboardist in his father, Sir

Uwaifo Snr was a prominent
Nigerian singer and performer from
the early 1960's, well known
for classic hits such as Joromi and
Mammy water". Additionally, he
was the first African to earn
a Gold Disc. In the years after he
left his Father's band, Andre Vibez
began to devote more time
to music production and soon

established himself as a key figure in assisting young artists in his local community to hone their craft with notable beneficiaries including the then-young teen duo R" A (now known as solo artists Rema and Alpha P) and numerous other emerging musicians and artists.

Andre Vibez returned to producing in 2020 after a brief stint in corporate media as a production executive in the foremost Nigerian Media Company CMA. He has since created hit tracks for artists such as Ladipoe, Rema, Omahlay, Ayra starr, Crayon, Bayanni, Mr Eazi, DJ Neptune and label boss, Don Jazzy.
